Clustered Spires Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes
July 5, 2018

The meeting began at 7:00 after the group had gathered to begin a sit and sew of various community service items.

Minutes

The minutes from June 7 were approved as published in the June newsletter.

Treasurer's Report as of June 30, 2018

Joan provided the Treasurer's report:

Income \$3,452.93
Expenses (\$2,125.99)
Net Income \$1,326.94

Bank Balance as of 6/30/18 \$8,804.94

Committee Reports

Nancy Speck, for the Fundraising Committee, indicated that there is a t-shirt sign-up sheet on the back table. They are women's sizes and three colors. The cost of \$15 includes what we pay for the shirts as well a modest profit for the guild.

Nancy also indicated for the 2019 Quilt Construction Committee that she is still recruiting additional members and plans an organizational meeting in the next few weeks.

Frances Shearer advised that Round Robin bags are available to be picked up. They should be returned with the next phase completed in September. She has extra instructions if needed.

Jacque Janss for the Delaplaine Exhibit Committee said that pictures of items selected by the Delaplaine for publicity are on a display board. They were submitted by Joan Watkins, Danita Frisby and Olga Schricte. The title of the exhibit is "Quilting – Applique to Zentangle." She thanked Beth Johnson for doing photography for the project.

Sandy Dunning gave a report for the Marketing Committee. We are at the Walkersville Carnival now, with total profits so far of \$395. She said it seems like the baskets work because people like them and can't decide which so they end up buying more tickets. Sandy did a "special" for the 4th, offering a free raffle ticket for the pink quilt that was drawn at 7pm. The result was \$216 for that one night. She urged members to sign up for Capital Quilts and other venues.

Grace Thorne for the Community Service Committee thanked everyone for coming and indicated that there are still kits available if anyone wants to take them home to complete. Everything should be returned for the October meeting. Quilts of Valor representatives will be at that meeting. Grace also advised that the supply list is available for the August Hawaiian quilting workshop. She emphasized that lots of batting is needed – polyester only, no cotton.

Someone is needed for next month for refreshments. Please contact Linda Beavers.

Brenda Barnhardt advised of the availability of a treadle machine that is to be given away. Anyone interested should contact Brenda.

After door prizes and Show and Tell, sit and sew continued.

HAND APPLIQUE HAWAIIAN QUILT PATTERN, PAPER AND BATTING WILL BE PROVIDED

- paper and fabric scissors
- applique and quilting needles
- fine thread for applique to match your applique design fabric
- quilting thread (if hand quilting)
- basting thread
- 12" square of fabric for backing
- 12" square of fabric for applique background
- 12" square of applique design fabric
- 12-14" square of **high-loft** polyester batting
- beeswax, thimble, iron, lamp or any other notions that you normally use

NOTE; IF YOU ARE USING A BATIK FABRIC PLEASE WASH 3X FOR FLEXIBILITY....
