Each year the guild donates quilts to one or more community nonprofits. Examples of past projects have included donations to cancer foundations, refugees, senior citizen organizations, homeless and shelter settings, veteran's hospice, and more.

PROGRAMS

We hire local, national, and international speakers to present lectures and workshops to our guild. Presentations may be in person or virtual. Most workshops are presented virtually so that attendees can participate from the comfort of their homes.

Programs also include themed show-and-tells, an annual design challenge and more! We have a broad range of skill levels and enjoy both sharing and learning with one another.



BIENNIAL QUILT SHOW

We hold a quilt show to display member creations at the Delaplaine every other year in December. Our 2022 exhibition called "The Colors of Our World" focused on our 2022 challenge to use all seven colors of the rainbow. Other works were also submitted by members -- all skill levels and quilting styles are encouraged to submit quilts for exhibit.
