


CSQG December 2025 BOM



Tree Block (12 inch finished)



This month's block is the Tree Block. It involves some cutting of shapes that may be challenging for some of you. We're going to use some templates. Not to worry if you've never used templates until now. There is a first time for everything. Learning new skills is a benefit of the block of the month program!

Let's get started!

Cutting directions for one 12½ inch unfinished block: (all measurements are in inches)

For one block you will:


- Cut from Light/Sky Blue: 2 – 10 1/8-inch by 6 ¾-inch rectangles AND 2 – 5 ½-inch by 3 ½-inch rectangles (Piece C)
- Sub-cut one 10 1/8-inch by 6 ¾-inch rectangle diagonally **right side up**, corner to corner going from lower left to upper right. You will only use one. (Piece A)
- Sub-cut one 10 1/8-inch by 6 ¾-inch rectangles diagonally **right side up**, corner to corner going from upper left to lower right. You will only use one. (Piece B)
- Cut from Dark/Brown: 1 – 3 ½-inch by 2 ½-inch rectangle (Piece D)
- Cut from Dark/Green: 2 – triangle shapes, use Template E
- Cut from Medium/Green: 1 – diamond shape, use Template F


NOTE: All seams are sewn with a scant ¼-inch.

1. Match one short side of Piece E to each lower side of Piece F and sew.
2. Sew Piece A to right side of Pieced E/F unit.
3. Sew Piece B to left side of Pieced E/F unit.
4. Sew Pieces C to each side of Piece D.
5. Sew unit made in Step 4 to the bottom of unit made in Step 3.
6. Press well and square up to 12 ½ inches.


